

## ***BLS for Healthcare Provider (C)***

The Basic Life Support (BLS) for Healthcare Providers (HCP) (C) is a course designed to teach a variety of healthcare professionals how to recognize a number of life-threatening emergencies, provide good quality CPR, how to use an AED and how to relieve choking in a safe, timely and effective manner.

### ***Who Is Eligible To Take This Course?***

This course is for healthcare professionals who must know how to perform CPR, as well as other lifesaving skills, in a range of in-hospital and out-of-hospital settings.

- Relief of choking for adult, child and infant
- CPR with an advanced airway
